FITTING INSTRUCTIONS (Included in Product Packaging) - Sample for Hilux Dual Cab

Check kit supplied is for vehicle being fitted and that kit is complete as listed.

Read the instructions to be sure you understand all aspects of fitting the vehicle before proceeding.

- Assemble the two Stepboards by fixing the moulded plastic end caps to one end of each board with M8 x 14mm bolts and flange nuts. Slide into each channel on the underside of boards three M8 hex nuts (6 per board). Fit to the remaining end of the board the other plastic end cap supplied in the kit.
- 2. Starting on either side of the vehicle, proceed as follows: Move to the underside of the vehicle and attach the three Stepboard brackets front, centre and rear on each side

Front Bracket – fit to the captive stud and secure with M8 flange nut and M8 x 20mm bolt and lock washer into the captive nut (refer diagram 1)


Centre and Rear Brackets – fit and secure with the M8 x 20mm bolts and flange nuts into existing holds in the body braces (refer diagram 2)

NB: The brackets are identified with stamped part numbers (see kit contents details)

3. Lift the assembled Stepboards onto the fitted brackets, position and attach with M8 x 14mm bolts, lock washers and flat washers, picking up nuts in the channels on the underside of the steps




FRONT BRACKET
